



## TRANSITIONAL SUBSIDIZED EMPLOYMENT (TSE) - PAID WORK EXPERIENCE (PWE)

### Attention All Non-profit Businesses & Government Organizations in LA County

The Transitional Subsidized Employment (TSE) program provides entry-level subsidized employment opportunities for CalWORKs and other eligible participants. TSE helps people overcome barriers to employment with the goal of enabling them to secure unsubsidized employment after completion of a TSE assignment.

Training assignments pay minimum wage. Participants can work up to 40 hrs/week for a 10 month period.

South Bay WIB serves as Employer of Record and pays all wages, tax and workers compensation costs.

Workers are recruited and screened to meet your agency's needs!
